2010 Beekeeping Workshops with Les Crowder

Backyard Beekeeping (Classes for the hobbyist)

These classes are designed for small home operations. They may be taken either individually or as a series. The series will be taught in both Albuquerque, NM and Rio Lucio, NM.

- **Introduction to Beekeeping**: This class will include instruction on obtaining bees, building a hive and understanding basic bee biology.
- **Spring Hive Maintenance**: This class is for students who already have bees and would like to understand how to sup press swarming, manage combs as the hive is growing and recognize signs of a healthy queen and brood nest.
- **Summer Hive Maintenance**: This class will spend detailed time in hives, looking at comb maintenance, troubleshoot ing problems and understanding hive development. Making divides and raising queens will also be covered in this class.
- **Fall Hive Maintenance**: This class will look at how to harvest and process honey, combine weak hives, evaluate winter stores of honey, and prepare the hives for the cold season.
- Making Wax Products: This class will teach students how to make their own solar wax melter, refine wax, and make salves, candles and soap.

The Backyard Beekeeping classes will be held on the following Sundays from 10am - 5pm.
