Interested in reusing your home's grey water? Want to save money and have a lovely garden? Come to our design and installation workshop and learn how to irrigate your landscape with grey water. In this class you'll learn about: Types of grey water systems, the new Californía code, appropriate landscape design and plants for grey water, common mistakes in system designs, and suítable products to use.

This is a hands-on class, so come prepared to work outside. We'll be installing grey water systems from the washing machine and shower to irrigate plants outside. This type of system is legal to install with out a permit following basic guidelines.

Alden is a graduate of the internationally renowned Center for Agro-ecology and Sustainable Food Systems program at the University of California, Santa Cruz. Following an extended period of travel in Asia, Alden found that traditional farming practices had been largely abandoned and replaced by the globalization of Western agriculture. This was a wake up call, seeing that even in the most remote areas of India,
 hybrid seeds, chemical fertilizers, and pesticides were the norm. He began to dedicate his path to organic gardening practices, regenerating the soil, social justice, and acting as if the earth really matters.
