Seed Saving Workshop


with Oscar Carmona at Mesa Harmony Garden

Located in the heart of the Mesa in beautiful Santa Barbara, Mesa Harmony Garden is on the corner of Meigs Road and Dolores Drive.

From the 101 Freeway:

Take the Carillo Street Exit and head toward the ocean. Head up and over the hill (Carillo Street becomes Meigs Road) and turn left on Dolores Drive. Park along the street, the garden is on the corner.



For the 2nd year running, Oscar will lead a hands-on workshop focused on planting open pollinated lettuce varieties well suited to the cooler ocean influenced micro-climate of the Mesa area. This year, participants will have a chance to prep beds, plant seedlings grown from the seeds collected from last year's crop, and discuss our plan for managing this crop. Once again, the seeds will be harvested and shared with the Foodbank, Mesa Harmony, and Guild and workshop participants. This workshop is free of charge and open to entire community!
