Friday, May 16, 1-3pm

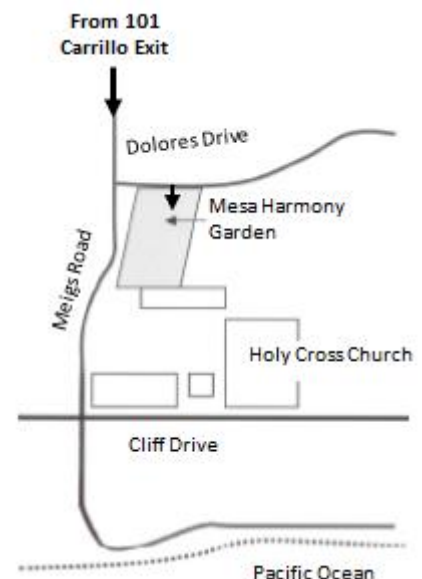
