

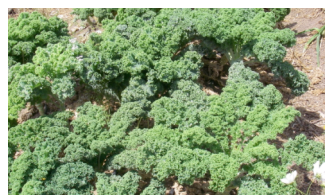
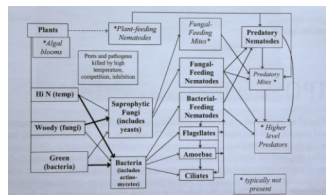
# LEARN TO MAKE QUALITY COMPOST AND UNDERSTAND THE SOIL FOOD WEB

- Increase soil organisms and beneficial microbes.

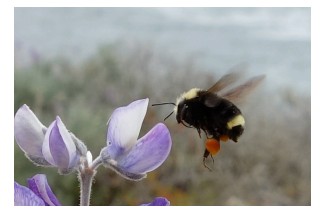
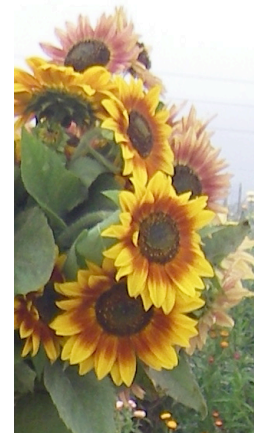
