The public can help prepare Our Global Family Village for the Fall Harvest Festival:
 - Join Garden Master, Janine Rands , on Tuesdays and Thursdays through Oct 5 from 1 to 5pm. Plant, weed, and perform garden maintenance. No experience necessary.
 - September 23 Community Work Day 10am 2pm Replant the herb garden in the European section of the farm. Mulch the pathways in the four quadrants of the garden to showcase food crops from the four corners of the globe.
 - The newest tenant, Ryan Brantley, has planted the front 2.5 acre plot with buckwheat and Sudan Grass cover crop in preparation for growing strawberries and various vegetables in early autumn. Ryan has an M.S. in Agriculture from Cal Poly and currently manages the research farms at the Cal Poly Strawberry Center.
 - Michael Huggins has been growing turmeric and garlic in his greenhouse. He's adding a new greenhouse. See what's growing, ask questions and learn about the plans for Huggins farm.
 - Veteran City Farm SLO farmer, Javier Magana, owns and operates Red Barn Farms. His knowledge, experimentation, and passion have contributed to his success and the demand for his wide variety of seasonal crops.
