Kenneth Haggard is a registered architect with decades' experience in urban design and architecture. He is the principal in San Luis Sustainability Group. A pioneer in passive solar design, Haggard designs residential and commercial projects with an emphasis on making best use of energy and materials available on site. He served as architect and senior researcher for the first passive solar house in California and co-wrote, *Passive Solar Handbook for California*, a guide for architects interested in passive solar design. With partner Polly Cooper, Haggard helped renew serious interest in straw bale construction by designing the first permitted straw bale house in the state.
