Participants will complete SV inspired and equipped to design resilient projects that are steeped in social and environmental justice. Immersion in experiential, mentorship-based projects offers your teen alternative perspectives, role models, and livelihoods that shape the directions of their lives. When students return home, they'll be able to apply these tools as leaders in their own communities.

LOGISTICS

Course Dates: June 24th-July 15th, 2017

Location: Quail Springs is located in the Coast Ranges of the Southern California mountains in a quiet canyon of the Cuyama Valley, surrounded on three sides by the ruggedly beautiful Los Padres National Forest. The site is little over an hour's drive north from Ojai, CA.

Course Tuition: \$2,825, \$250 deposit required upon acceptance - payment plans are available
